











1. How much of syllabus was covered by the teachers in your class?



10. Teachers inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes?





12. The teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications?



13. The teachers identify your strengths and encourage you with providing right level of challenges?




14. Teachers are able to identify your weaknesses and help you to overcome them?










17. Teachers encourage you to participate in extracurricular activities?


18. Efforts are made by the institute/ teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make you ready for the world of work?

19. What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia, etc. while teaching?





20. The overall quality of teaching-learning process in your institute is very good?



3. Were the teachers well prepare for the classes?



4. The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as?



5. What were the degrees of fairness of internal evaluation conducted by the teachers?


